

Dry Ice Handling & Safety Information

Ignoring Dry Ice Safety Instructions And Proper Handling Guidelines
Can Lead To Serious Injury, Up To And Including Death.

Please make sure to read, understand and comply with the following precautions. Ask for further clarification if unsure about any of this information.

Dry Ice is Carbon Dioxide in a solid form. Carbon Dioxide will displace oxygen in an enclosed, poorly vented area, causing death by asphyxia / suffocation. Carbon Dioxide is heavier than air and so is even more dangerous in below-grade spaces.

Never leave Dry Ice unattended around children.

Dry Ice is very cold to the touch at approx. -79° Celcius or -110° Farenheit & will cause frostbite and other serious injury, similar to burns, immediately upon contact with skin.

Never put Dry Ice in your mouth or swallow it. Never put Dry Ice next to bare skin. It is very dangerous to bare skin, mouth, and gastrointestinal tissue.

Do Not add Dry Ice to any beverages.

Never put Dry Ice into a tightly sealed container such as a bottle, thermos etc. As Dry ice sublimates into a gas, the area it occupies will expand. If Dry Ice is placed in any form of tightly sealed container, this action will result in a container rupture or an explosion, threatening health and life.

Always use protective gloves, towels or tongs when handling Dry Ice.

Store Dry Ice safely in a "camping" type of cooler, Styrofoam box or proper Dry Ice chest. Placing Dry Ice in a mechanical freezer of any kind may potentially damage other contents of the freezer and will cause the product to sublimate at a higher rate, reducing useful length of time the product can be useful.

When Transporting Dry Ice by car, Always place the Dry Ice cooler, or other non-tightly sealed container, in the trunk of the vehicle or at least as far from the passengers as possible. Leave one or two windows at least slightly open to ensure fresh air ventilation. Do not rely on your vehicle's AC or heating system to provide ventilation.
